The Bethel Baptist Church was organized in 1798, as an anti-slavery church. Obed Denham abolitionist and founder of Bethel, donated two lots for the church to abolitionist and founder of Bethel, donated two lots for the church to build a meeting house and cemetery. Denham placed a deed restriction upon the gift, prohibiting the use by "those who hold slaves or commune at the Lord's table with those who practice slavery". The church became the first emancipating society west of the Alleghenies. The church joined an in-slavery Baptists of Kentucky. These lots were given with the stipulation that the church not have communion with slaveholders.




